PREVENTION OF DISEASE/INFECTION TRANSMISSION

The Board is committed to providing a healthful environment for all students and employees. To prevent disease transmission and promote a healthy educational/social environment in the district, the Board adopts the policy and guidelines established by the Superintendent of Schools. The guidelines provide for the control of the spread of communicable diseases and exclusion from work and/or school of any person with a variety of viral or bacterial communicable diseases.

Actions taken with respect to students or employees found to have a communicable disease will be consistent with rights afforded individuals under state and federal statutory, regulatory, and Constitutional provisions. Each case of said student or staff member will be treated on an individual basis.

The superintendent, or designee, will be responsible for determining the information to be disseminated to staff, parents, and community when a communicable disease is identified or suspected in the school setting.
