**EMERGENCY CLOSINGS/DELAY OF OPENING**

Schools shall be open every scheduled day. On stormy days parents are encouraged to use their own judgment in keeping children at home, if they deem this is in the best interest of the child's safety and welfare.

If the weather becomes extremely hazardous, or on occasions of exceptional public importance, the superintendent is empowered to close or delay the opening of the schools. A full report of the circumstances shall be made at the next regular meeting of the Board.
