### FOOD SERVICES MANAGEMENT

The school system, in compliance with federal and state law and with the rules and regulations of the Department of Education, shall operate a school nutrition program, which shall be under the direction of the food service director. The superintendent shall exercise control of the overall operation and efficiency of the school nutrition program and its expenditures.

In organizational relationship, the school lunch supervisor in each school is directly responsible to the food service director, but shall cooperate with the principal of the school in matters essential to the proper functioning of the food services program. The responsibility for control of students using the cafeteria shall rest with the building principal.

The Board shall approve the prices set for school lunches and the price of milk.

As required for participation in the National School Lunch Program, the Board agrees to the following regulations:

1. That a "Type A" lunch be made available for students.
2. That free and reduced-price lunches be provided students who cannot afford to pay the price of the "Type A" lunch.

Students shall also be permitted to bring their lunches from home and to purchase milk and incidental items.
