

SCHOOL YEAR

The law requires that the schools be in session for at least 180 days annually. However, the negotiated contract between the Messalonskee School District (MSAD 47) and the Messalonskee Teacher's Association provides for 184 days annually, of which not less than 175 shall be actual school days, and no more than five may be devoted to in-service education of teachers.

The State Department of Education may reduce or waive the minimum number of days upon duly submitted request of the Board, if sufficient reason is given to support such request.
